Graduate students in Human Sciences or students taking the **Minor Program** with GLOCOL have an opportunity to work on both these sets of skills this September with two invited seminar facilitators.

Professor Rowena Murray author of *The Academic Writing Handbook* and *Writing for Academic Journals* and **Professor Jeremiah Mock**, medical anthropologist currently on a Fulbright fellowship from University of California will be running an intensive week of seminars on academic writing and presentation skills. The course is coordinated by **Dr Beverley Yamamoto**.

Criteria for participation (受講要件)

- 1) Abstract of 300 words describing the topic that you want to turn into a journal article and presentation.
- 2) Four sentences explaining your expectations and goals for the course
- 3) List of three journals where you might want to publish this paper

The upper limit is **20 participants** and selection will be on the basis of the above criteria.
