Graduate Student Data Collection and Analysis Support Funding

Funding Guidelines

1. Overview

Graduate students seeking financial support for data collection, analysis, and basic research are urged to submit applications for funding for fiscal 2009.

This will be the only application opportunity for this year.

The following activities will be funded:

- (1) Data collection and analysis
- (2) Research that will be the basis for data collection and analysis
- (3) Hosting conferences to announce research results, and participation in conferences and workshops (scheduling is possible)

2. Eligibility requirements

Applicants must currently be enrolled as graduate students in the Department of Human Sciences. Students who are on leave, or students who are planning to go on leave, and Research Fellows of the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (DC1 or DC2) are not eligible to apply.

3. Time period

From mid-May 2009 to the end of February 2010.

4. Budget

600,000 yen or less.

The budget is to be constructed appropriate to the objectives and plans of the research.

5. Submission deadline

Date: April 13, 2009 (Deadline: 15:00)

Place: Office for the Education and Research (School of Human Sciences, North wing 305)

6. Announcement of results

The results are scheduled to be announced on April 30, 2009.

An explanatory meeting for successful applicants will be held after the May holidays. Students who are selected are required to attend. (No English translation will be provided.)

7. Research results report

A report must be submitted within the year for research that has received financial support. In addition, a report of research results may be requested for the 2010 report-out session. Details regarding the report and the research results report will be communicated at a later date.

* An advance information session regarding the support funding will be held on April 3, 12:30 – 13:20 in Humaine Hall. Students who are considering applying for funding should attend.
